**Title of Change:** Additional IRIX 6.5 Baseline Changes - Revision A to CCR 00-0793

1. Per Attachment #1, Update the HW/SW maps so that the SGI hosts highlighted are baselined for BDS, HiPPI SW and HiPPI adapter firmware. This software/firmware group should always appear together or not at all. BDS is currently listed for some NSIDC SGI hosts and should be removed, as HiPPI is not implemented at this site on any SGI hosts. HiPPI is not implemented on any AQG hosts at any site. LARC's I0icg hosts will also include this software/firmware when IRIX 6.5 hardware movement is completed, but not currently.
2. Per Attachment #2, add the COTS software to the HW/SW map baselines for Console1 and Console 2 hosts previously added to the HW-SW maps.
3. Per Attachment #3 mark-up to 910-TDA-003 (COTS Version Baseline), add IRIS Console, version 2.0 to COTS Version Baseline.
4. Per Attachment #4 mark-up to 920-TDE-002, change the software baseline for e0drg05, which will retain it's curent name, but will change it's function to a secondary WKG host. New software baseline reflects this functionality.
5. Per Attachment #5 mark-up to 920-TDL-002, add the software baseline for previously baselined IRIX 6.5 new host: I0spg10.
6. COTS products DBTools.h++, Tools.h++, ToolsPro, BX/Epak, and HDF are no longer delivered as separate COTS products, as they are currently delivered with the Custom Code. Although these products, should be baselined on the COTS version map, they should not be directly linked to specific hosts as they were in the past when dymanically linked and delivered as separate COTS products. Links to specific DAAC, PVC and VATC machines should be removed as individually linked COTS products as this could cause unintended and inappropriate audit findings.
